



March Fashion Industry Night – Top Designers Preview

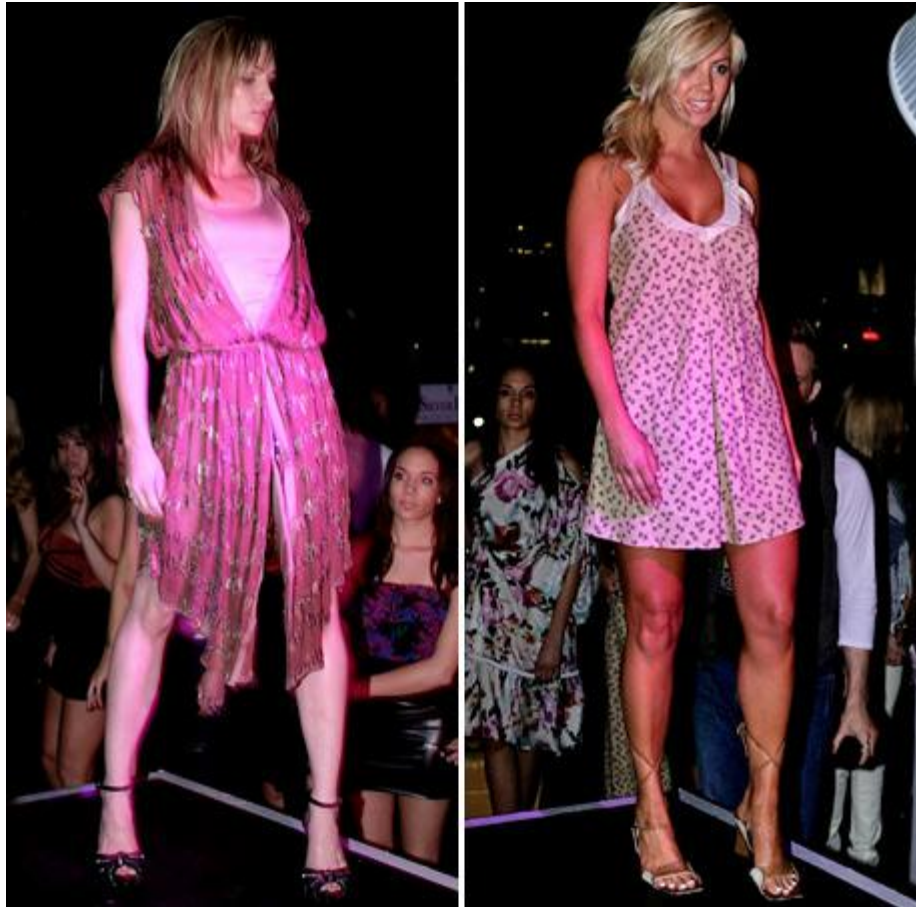
